

## **King and Messiah Week 32**

When we are reading a book or watching a movie, why do we picture ourselves more like the heroes than the villains?

### **Read Matthew 26:1-2 and Matthew 26:26-29**

What similarities does the Lord's Supper share with Passover? Why is it important to remember Christ's death as a community?

### **Read Matthew 26:6-13 and Luke 7:36-50**

These are two separate instances of women unashamedly worshipping Jesus. What do we learn from how they worship, Jesus' response to their worship, and the surrounding people's reactions?

### **Read Matthew 26:20-25**

Why do you think the disciples wondered if it could be them who betrayed Jesus?

In what ways is it significant that the disciples couldn't immediately point to Judas as the culprit?

### **Read Matthew 26:30-35 and Proverbs 11:2**

Why would Peter think he's so different from the others that he would never deny Jesus?

How should drawing near to God increase our humility rather than our pride?

### **Read Matthew 26:36-46**

How can Jesus' prayers be a guide for our prayers during trial and temptation?

Jesus had asked the disciples to be alert and pray, but they only managed to fall asleep. What keeps you from living faithfully?

### **Read Matthew 26:57-68**

How are we similar to the religious leaders and those who accuse and mock Jesus in this passage?

### **Read Matthew 26:69-75**

How is Peter's story of denial sad, yet hopeful?

Why must we experience what Peter experienced in verse 75 in order to fully worship Jesus? (Think about the women we studied earlier)
